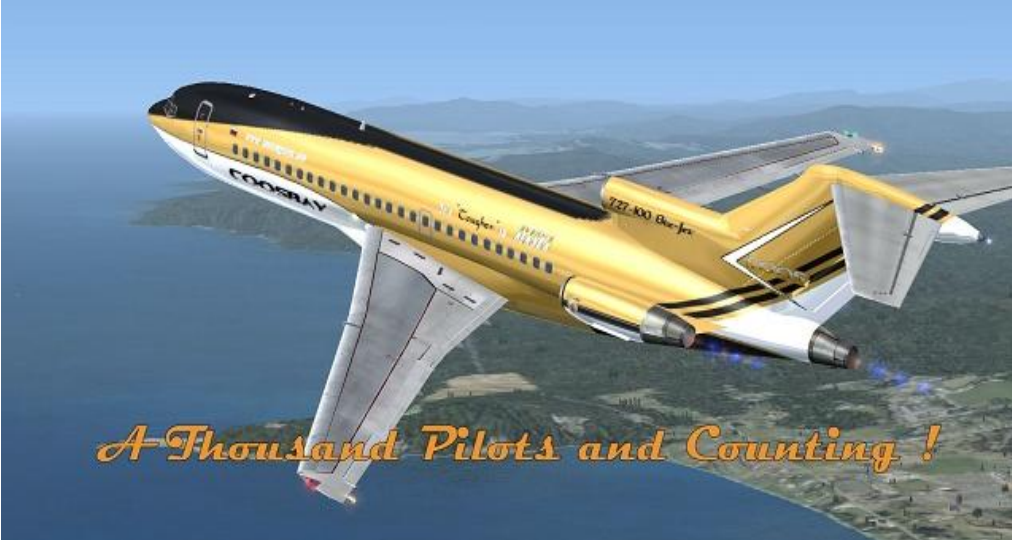

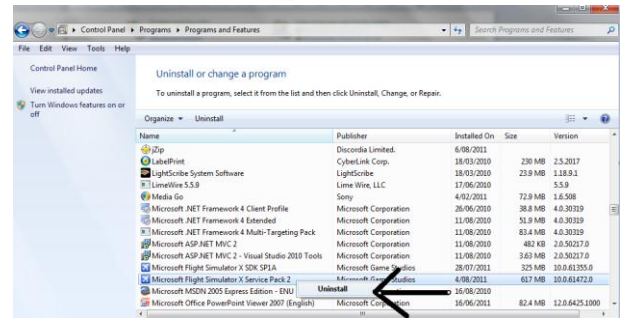


*Repair-disk is giving you a headache?  
Follow these simple instructions ...*



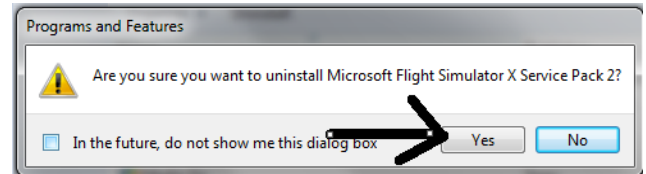
*Click on the Start button and select  
Control Panel\Programs\Programs and Features.*

*Find Microsoft Flight Simulator X Service Pack 2 or  
Acceleration, right click, press Uninstall.*

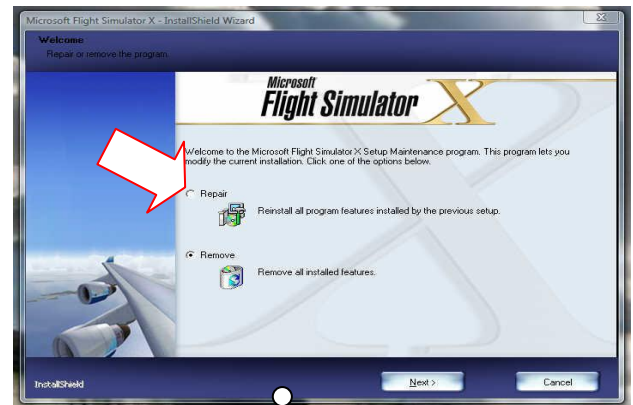


*Click Yes.*

*This will remove Service Pack 2 or Acceleration.  
Once it is done, you are ready to repair FSX.*



*Insert disk one into your drive. Select “Repair” and  
click Next.*



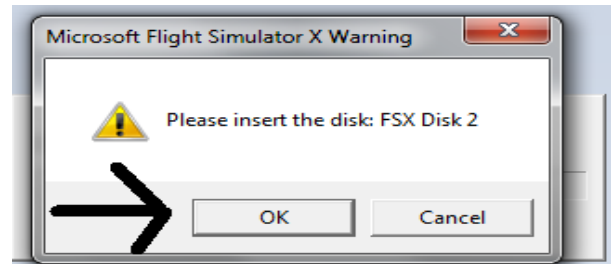
*Be patient ... your screen may show this window,  
just let it run.*



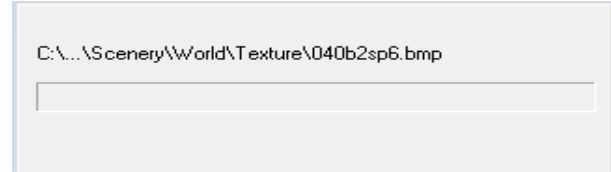
*The computer will start repairing files. This could  
take a while.*



*Insert Disk 2 and click OK to continue repairing files.*



*This could take a while.*



*When maintenance has been completed, the following box will show up. Click finish.*



*Run Flightsim to sort out indexes and wait until this is done and then close Flightsim.*



You may now install Service Pack 2 or Acceleration.

Coosbay members prefer Service Pack 2. If you choose this, you may download Service Pack 2 from the Coosbay website at <http://coosbayhops.com/?display=FEFD5506-F0A1-4832-82B8-8ECC2B8E92A9>. Save this on your desktop, click on Service Pack 2 icon, and complete the installation.

If Acceleration is your choice, insert the Acceleration disk and complete the process.

Run Flightsim.

You will notice that the program runs better.

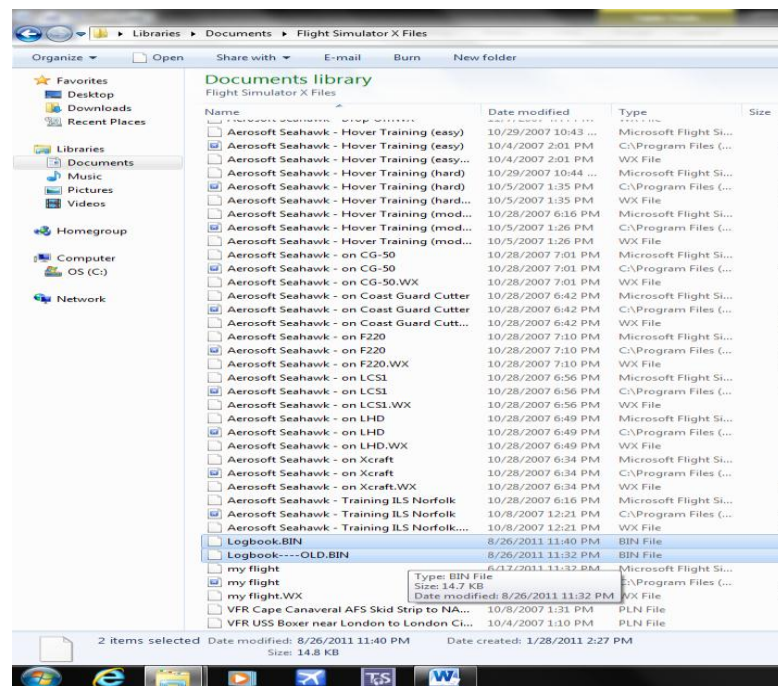
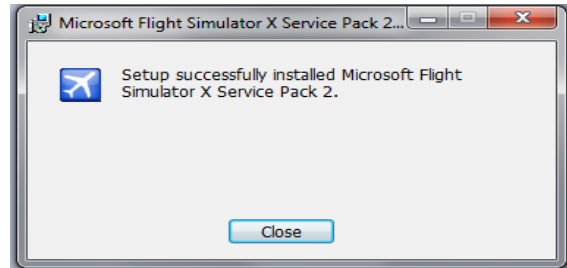
Repair disk can improve your frame rate and may help you and others from getting disconnected from flight sessions.

Flightsim is starting slowly? Clear the Logbook that may contain corrupt flightlogs ...

Access Documents\Flight Simulator X Files, and find "Logbook.BIN".

Delete or rename this file (I renamed mine as Logbook---OLD.BIN). Then start flightsim and observe the difference. If this did not improve your flightsim start-up, you may go back and delete the newly created Logbook.BIN file by flightsim and rename the old file as the Logbook.BIN and you are back where you started.
